Math with lids	<p>Gather 10 or more lids and caps of all different shapes and sizes. You can find lids on containers around the house or on recyclables. The more you can collect, the more math and fun you can have.</p> <p>Sort the lids by color, size, shape, what it is made of and what kind of container it fits on. Use your words to describe the lids. "It is blue, it has ridges, it is smooth on top, it rolls," etc. Which set of lids contains more? Fewer? How could you make the sets equal?</p> <p>Try arranging them from smallest to largest.</p>
